Key Findings and Issues	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Large open site with range of pitch sizes, all rated standard. 1 adult, 2 x 9v9, 1 x 7v7 and 2 x 5v5. 2. Ground is used by range of teams – Frampton 3rd XI and Frampton u16s, and a further 5 junior teams and 5 mini teams 3. As well as matches, the grounds hosts around of festivals, events and training events throughout the year. There is some spare capacity including at peak times but in general the ground is well and efficiently used. 4. The major issue for the club (apart from improving the drainage of the adult pitch) is their aspiration for indoor training facilities. There is an area of the ground not currently used for pitches where a mini size indoor training area could be provided. 5. In essence, the club spend a huge budget on training each year on outdoor AGPs; these are not ideal for younger players and the club is committed to providing a safe, warm indoor training venue which can be used throughout the year for a variety of activities.
