I would like to comment on these proposals.

1 They seem to be far too large for the area. The housing would not fulfill a local need but would merely create a commuter town. As such the local roads would not cope with this level of traffic. Most of these properties would be at least 2 car families all travelling a peak time. At the moment traffic backs up into Stone village trying to turn on to the M5.

2 This development seems to be the easy option rather than a development in the Stroud valleys where there is much more potential for employment.

3 The local infrastructure cannot support this level of development.

4 Should not the housing developments be nearer the centres of employment rather than rely on extra car journeys.
