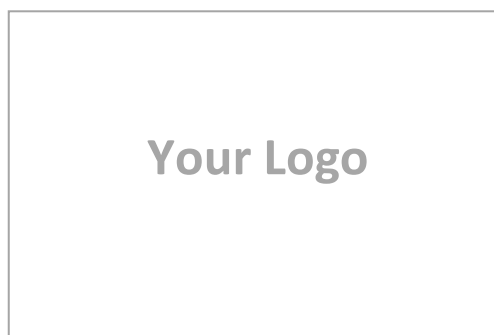

Installation of bus shelter, Stagholt, Standish GL10 2HQ and relocation of bench

Brief description of works undertaken:

A wooden bus shelter, in keeping with the rural nature of Standish parish, has been installed at a well-used bus stop where previously there was no shelter. A bench, previously located at the bus stop, has been relocated to Standish village green and permanently fixed to a new concrete pad.
