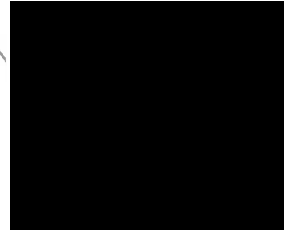

Dear Sir / Madam,

I am writing to object to the consideration of additional development of land in Hardwicke village designated as G1 in the current consultation documents.

I can see no need for this additional development as local needs are being met in the Hunts Grove site which is providing additional capacity and facilities for development by Gloucester or Stroud Councils.

There is much easier access and flexibility of routing to the major traffic routes from east side of the A38.

If Gloucester City needs more housing there are plenty of other sites.

The exit roads and lanes in and out of Hardwicke to Gloucester and to the south are already stressed and dangerous with traffic.

I note there already appears to be construction work started on the old Bristol road at the A38 exit for Quedgeley further impacting our village.

Hardwicke village has managed to retain its rural village feel and atmosphere despite the numerous residential encroachments and very large commercial developments in and around the parish.

It has also been further burdened with the stigma and operational emissions of an incinerator nearby.

Surely, it's time to give the parish some relief from further large-scale development!
