I wish to object to the plan for 80+ houses on this site. It would mean about 160 vehicles would need to be accommodated many of which would be passing through Dursley between 07.00hrs and 09.30hrs then later between 16.00hrs and 18.30hrs daily (excluding Sunday).

I use these time periods three times each week and often spend 10 to 15 minutes at the junction of Henlow Drive and the road through Dursley trying to get into the line of traffic. I am old enough to have the patience to wait for a safe chance to break into it but not everyone has that much time to waste and may endeavour to make up time later on the journey. This adds additional pollution to the air close to Henlow Court (home for the elderly).

The additional vehicles from the proposed site simply add to the congestion. Perhaps traffic lights at some of the junctions with the main road might reduce the congestion. In addition, every blade of grass, bush or tree destroyed reduces the uptake of carbon and nitrogen oxides from the atmosphere which in turn leads to some global warming and pollution.
