Land To The East Of Stamages Lane is in a sustainable location and is located within Painswick's settlement boundary that is considered to be an accessible settlement with limited facilities and a third tier settlement, which provides the best opportunity outside the local service centres for growth and greater self containment, as set out in the SDC Local Plan (Nov 2015)

The site is located within the Cotswold Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) and is currently in agricultural use as pasture land.

The site currently has an outline consent for the erection of a four bedroom detached dwelling with access not reserved (S.17/0792/OUT). The access gained from Stamages Lane was deemed acceptable to faciltate a residential development and the visibility is good in both directions.

The site at circa 0.8 hectares could accommodate circa 20 dwellings, however design and layout would need to be clearly considered to respect the surrounding AONB designation.

The site is also located to the east of SALA ref: PAI007 (Land at Stamages), which was considered to have future potential to accommodate development. It should be considered that our clients site is must better suited than this site, as it has an existing access and an extant permission for a C3 use.

The site is sufficiently screened from the surrounding open countryside and there would appear to be no overriding physical constraints or potential impacts preventing sensitively located development for a medium scale housing scheme.
