As a resident of Slimbridge, I am writing to object to the proposal in the Emerging Strategy Paper to build the new 'Wisloe Green' settlement near Cambridge:

- The plan to build 1500 new homes near Cam and Dursley seems very disproportionate.
- Wisloe Green uses farming land, not brownfield sites
- The current amenities, infrastructure and transport systems are already stretched flooding in recent years has highlighted the limitations of the sewage system the system has been paired but would not be sufficient to support such a disproportionate increase in use.
- The land forms an important part of the natural drainage system it is often very wet. Flooding has been an issue in this area covering such a large area with manmade materials has the potential to cause serious problems.
- A development of this size would vastly impact and change the character of the surrounding area and villages.
