I have already written the same letter to SDC planning but someone advised to send to you - so here it is again.

I am writing to you about my concerns regarding the proposed 5,000 houses along Old and New Brochend to Shopness / Newtown and then onto Wanswell and Belleley. I think the scale of this project is overwhelming and whilst destroying the beautiful countryside we have in and around the villages - Newtown, Shopness, Old & New Brochend and Wanswell, and our local town of Belleley it will also totally destroy these communities.

I appreciate that some houses are needed and some small infill sites such as Cromwell Close, Newtown and the new Cranbury site at Belleley are less invasive. Little projects like this would be much better. But to suddenly swamp the area with 5,000 houses will be awful.

For babies - where are the children going to go to school? The current primary schools are full and the secondary school is closed. The hospital and police station are shut. Shops here shut. The library is run by volunteers. The

doctor surgery @ Maybrook is struggling. Our base has shut. Then also 5,000 homes could bring another 10,000 - 15,000 cars. The roads at present are diabolical, parking is a major issue. Old lanes are being used as rat runs. The by-pass has never been completed. The motorway junction at Falfield is at breaking point. There is just NO INFRASTRUCTURE here for this.

People will come to the area and just commute straight back out everyday. They want to become part of the community. All our local history and communities will be lost forever.

I just hope this decision will be reversed. A small amount of homes here and there YES but not 5,000.
