Site Ref. NAIA (Land North of Nympsfield Road/Nortonwood Junction) is in a sustainable location and is located adjacent to Nailsworth's settlement boundary that is considered to be a Tier 2 Settlement / Local Service Centre where housing growth should be focused in the District (as set out in the Local Plan).

The site at circa 1.4 hectares could accommodate a significant number of dwellings (circa 40 dwellings).

Access is currently gained from Nympsfield Road, which has good visibility and is the subject of a 30 mph speed limit.

The site is sufficiently screened from the surrounding open countryside and low lying hedgerow currently fronts both Nortonwood Road and Nymsfield Road.

There would appear to be no overriding physical constraints or potential impacts preventing sensitively located development for a medium to large scale housing scheme. It should be considered that the site is the only preferred option in Nailsworth that has been selected as a broad location for future growth, which has been identified to accommodate a medium to large housing development.

Site Ref. NAIB (Land South of Lower Newmarket Road) is circa 0.14 hectares and is only able to accommodate small scale housing (circa 4 dwellings) as set out in the 2017 SALA (appendix 3). Site Ref. NAIC (North of Avening Road) has only been selected as an option for potential employment growth.

Bruton Knowles would like to express that the site is in single ownership and is immediately available and deliverable over the next 5 years. For these reasons the site would make an appropriate residential allocation.
