Re. S.D.C.'s Proposal to build on land to the north of Painswick, known as Washwell Fields.

I wish to object, once again, to this proposal, on the same grounds, as before, that it is -

1 Not in keeping with any of the older stone built houses, in and around Painswick, especially close by, and would ruin the approach to Painswick, which is one of the best known old towns in this part of the Cotswolds.

2 The access, which is apparently to be into ~~the~~ Washwell Lane, is ill thought out, and completely

inappropriate, as the lane itself is very narrow, as a lane implies, and has children walking up & down to catch, & return from school buses. Also cars arriving, & turning round in the lane, to pick some of them up.

3 The bend just off the main road is also quite dangerous to see round at times, as a number of cars & vans park there, to unload young children to go into the recreation ground, as access to the play area.

4 The access onto the main road at rush hours is also quite dangerous with cars coming in all directions, and with many more cars using the lane, it would be an accident waiting to happen.
