Good afternoon,

Thank you for letting residents have their say on this potential site.

I have also filled out an online questionnaire and I could give you a list of reasons as to why I object and they would be a mile long but I have condensed for easy reading:

Huge sites with thousands of potential builds will cause an irreplaceable disruption to wildlife and green spaces. Tearing down the trees and hedgelines we have increases our flood risk too (nearby canal in whitminster and reduced evaporation of rainwater)

public paths will be built over and destroyed.

A plan of 2250 houses will mean around 4500 more cars using the immediate slip road from the M5 and through-road to the village (going by the average of 2 cars per household) causing excessive traffic, pollution and RTC risk with the build up backing on to the lane one of the motorway.

More heavily populated areas naturally have higher crime rates which is why I am more supportive of wider dispersal of smaller areas as this makes for a more peaceful community feeling for existing and new dwellings who all equally can enjoy their surrounding green spaces rather than heavily developing small villages.
