Dear Sir or Madam

I wish to add to the conversation concerning the development of WASHWELL FIELDS (adjacent to Washwell Lane, Painswick)

1. The proposed access from Lower Washwell Lane is on a sharp bend also with a cul de sac access close by.
2. Lower Washwell Lane junction to the A46 is a notoriously difficult access particularly at peak traffic periods due to poor visibility in both directions.
- 3 The Lane is basically a single track lane serving an increasing number of dwellings.
4. There would be a serious adverse impact on the landscape, with the views to and from Sheepscombe being ruined. This is within an AONB.
5. The land is used for the grazing of cattle, any change of use would reduce the ability of local farmers to rear their stock.
6. This proposal again would increase the already stretched demands for local amenities such as schooling, retail shops, parking etc.

For the above reasons I strongly object to this proposal and wish you to consider my views during your deliberations.
